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КАФЕДРА ИНОСТРАННЫХ ЯЗЫКОВ

Курс иностранных языков изучался в Витебском ветеринарном институте с 1924 года. В 1952г. курс был преобразован в кафедру иностранных языков, заведующий кафедрой – Мануковский В.Н (1953-1957). В последующие годы кафедрой заведовали Ханевич И.С. (1957-1977), Семенюк Р.М. (1978-2003).

В настоящее время кафедра обеспечивает преподавание современных языков: английского, немецкого, французского, белорусского (профессиональная лексика), русского языка как иностранного и латинского языка. Кафедрой руководит старший преподаватель Картунова А.И. Штат кафедры включает 16 старших преподавателей, 1 ассистента. Учебно-вспомогательный состав кафедры – 3 лаборанта.

Улучшение качества обучения, интенсификация образовательного процесса, разработка дидактических материалов нового поколения, содействие формированию у студентов патриотического чувства гордости за свою академию, свою страну, формирование гуманистических ценностей определяются преподавателями кафедры как стратегические задачи.

Научно-исследовательская тема кафедры «Создание интегративной дидактической среды как средства повышения качества изучения языковых дисциплин в контексте инновационного образования» позволяет расширить дидактические возможности учебно-методического комплекса, оптимизировать управление учебной деятельностью, дополнить традиционные образовательные технологии инновационными, улучшить качество образовательного процесса.

Разработаны и внедрены в образовательный процесс 3 учебных пособия с грифом Министерства образования: «Английский язык / English» (авторы Картунова А.И., Калишук И.Е., Васильева Т.К., Тихонова Т.А., Крученкова Т.Н., Левкович Г.М.), «Латинский язык» (авторы Воронова Г.П., Елисеева Т.С., Агафонова О.В.), «Беларуская мова. Прафесійная лексіка». В период с 2012 по 2017 г. коллективом кафедры опубликовано более 120 печатных работ, включая монографии, статьи, учебно-методические пособия. Руководство научно-исследовательской работой студентов занимает значительное место в работе кафедры. Особое внимание уделяется работе с яркими, одаренными студентами и магистрантами, стремящимися реализовать свой творческий и научный потенциал. Количество публикаций по итогам НИРС за последние пять лет превышает 60 работ. Студенты принимают участие в республиканских конкурсах, олимпиадах, конференциях. Вклад кафедры в подготовку научных кадров высшей квалификации приобретает все возрастающую важность. На кафедре ведется подготовка к кандидатским экзаменам по программе магистратуры и соискателей ученой степени кандидата наук, работает комиссия по приему кандидатских экзаменов. Кафедра активно участвует в реализации образовательных программ ФПК и ПК, факультета довузовской подготовки, вносит свой вклад в международную деятельность академии.

По инициативе кафедры и при поддержке администрации для студентов академии ежегодно проводятся курсы углубленного изучения языка специальности по немецкому и английскому языкам.
